After this training, the educators will be awarded certificates; these will be issued according to performance and based on the assessment of their respective portfolios. We have gold, silver and bronze certificates.

In order for this training to take place, the following conditions apply:

- Each educator should have a computer
- The computers should have a disc drive (CD rom)
- All the Microsoft office applications should be working (word processor, spreadsheet, Publisher and PowerPoint)
- All the computers should be linked to a printer
- The computer lab must have **Internet or Encarta**
- The school must have a Data Projector

Prerequisite for Educators

- The educators should have **prior knowledge** of word processing and information skills as well as sound pedagogical knowledge.
- Educators should also bring along their Teaching Materials for example: Text Books, Flash disks (optional), Curriculum Statements etc.
